Details:

Last November 24, 2017, the 10th Community Conference with the theme “Unity in Diversity” was held at One Tagaytay Place, Tagaytay City. The activity is a follow-up event on the seminar workshop conducted by the School of Languages, Humanities and Social Sciences on UN’s Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The objective is to aid the community in developing projects and policies that respond to their needs.

Participants of the the event were from the thirty-five (35) communities of Pandacan, Manila and two (2) barangays of Intramuros, Manila. Seventy-nine (79) barangay officials attended the activity, of which twenty-five (25) were barangay chairmen.

Engr. Joyrence Mervin Q. Agas gave an overview of the conference’s topics and expected output. He reiterated the initiatives of Mapúa University, as far as extension service is concerned, are geared towards contributing to the attainment of the UN’s Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and of the Philippine Development Plan. He emphasized the need for a conscious and collaborative action among university stakeholders and the community partners.



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To introduce the workshop, a video presentation was shown to chronicle the changes and challenges in the past years and the efforts of the university and the communities. Included in the presentation was the success story of one of the residents in Pandacan who had undergone welding workshop in Mapúa University. This launched the topic of creating projects and opportunities for the communities using the University's pool of experts and facilities.

Guidelines in creating community project proposals were discussed. The participants were taught about the process and key elements of project development.




The workshop on project proposal making followed. As a baseline, the communities were requested to formulate project proposals that respond to their community. The theme of the proposed projects were as follows:

- Livelihood Projects – promotes alternative source of income
- Education – tutorials for the school aged children and skills training for the teenagers and adults
- Environment – urban farming/gardening and rehabilitation of community surroundings
- Health – information campaign regarding health issues and concerns
- Disaster Risk, Reduction and Management – creating a disaster-ready community

In the plenary forum, it was explained that the proposed projects will be reviewed by the university and will matched with the University's resources and expertise. It was reiterated that the project proposals that can be realized by the University will be coordinated and implemented in the succeeding year. Project proposals that are not within the scope of the University's capability will be referred to relevant agencies.

Mapúa-SOCIP discussed how to do banding techniques. This is in response to the need of the community with regard to Disaster Risk, Reduction and Management (DRRM). A video presentation was presented and a demonstration of the different bandaging styles was done. Participants were taught self-application bandaging techniques.

The Pledge of Commitment followed to further concretized the relationship between the University and the communities of Pandacan and Intramuros.
