The workshop concentrated on six (6) SDGs namely SDG 1 – No Poverty, SDG 2 – Zero Hunger, SDG 3 – Good Health and Well Being, SDG 6 – Clean Water & Sanitation, SDG 7 – Affordable & Clean Energy and SDG 16 – Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions. Participants brainstormed possible ideas for ordinances that tackles their assigned SDGs. Several groups came up with proposed ordinances which were anchored to several legislative policies and protocols for proper streamlining to the barangay level.

DRAFT GUIDELINES

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT, SUPPORT AND FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF MANILA CITY ORDINANCE 8572 – “TAPAT KO, LINIS KO”

1. Advocacy for cleanliness and orderliness of being. The perimeter must be fully implemented and enforced.
2. Efforts of the local government alone is not sufficient in providing and maintaining cleanliness and orderliness.
3. Collaboration of the group is needed and prevents the proliferation of continued practice of indiscriminate display of visual clutters.
4. Adopts measures to ensure and protect the health, social, moral welfare of others
5. Cleanliness of the venue shall not only encourage and attract other groups but also provide health and environmental benefits

SDG 6 – CLEAN WATER & SANITATION

LIST OF POSSIBLE ORDINANCE TOPIC

1. Establishment of septic tank in every household or building
2. Regulation for apartments or for rent establishments
 - a. Should have their own comfort room or toilet
 - b. Should have their own water connection and service
 - c. Should have a properly installed or maintained water line or pipes
 - d. Water line or pipes should be located away from drainage or canal
3. Prohibition regarding loitering animals or pets
4. Installation of Public Toilets
5. Prohibition regarding urinating in public places
6. Strengthening of “Tapat mo Linis mo” program that promote cleanliness in the environment

DRAFT GUIDELINES

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING EVERY HOUSEHOLD OR BUILDING TO HAVE OR CONSTRUCT SEPTIC TANK

Whereas, the Barangay Council finds it necessary to require every household or building to have or construct septic tanks.

Whereas, according to PD No. 856 Lawphil. “It is responsibility of operators of water to submit.

Whereas, the health of the people, being of paramount importance, all efforts of public service should be directed towards the protection and promotion of health; and

Whereas, with the advance in the field of sanitation in recent years, there arises the need for updating and codifying our scattered sanitary laws to ensure that they are in keeping with modern standard of sanitation and provide a handy reference and guide for this enforcement.

Now therefore Barangay Council find it necessary to require every household or building to have or construct septic tanks in the barangay.

SDG 7 – AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY
