SUBJECT: AVAILABILITY OF MOBILITY AIDS FOR EMPLOYEES AND STUDENTS IN THE

HEALTH SERVICES CLINIC

The MAPUA UNIVERSITY administration understands that physical disability should not be a reason for someone to be deprived of the right to proper education and access to services. That is why we at the Health Services Department would like it to be known that mobility aids e.g. wheel chairs and leg crutches/walking canes are available both to our students and to employees who may be of need of them while they are in campus. If a student or employee with permanent or temporary physical disability would find it difficult to go about within campus because of their disability, they may secure the use of such walking aids in our Health Services clinic, albeit temporarily, while they are in campus. The use of such devices will be free of charge and will only require them to register at the clinic.
