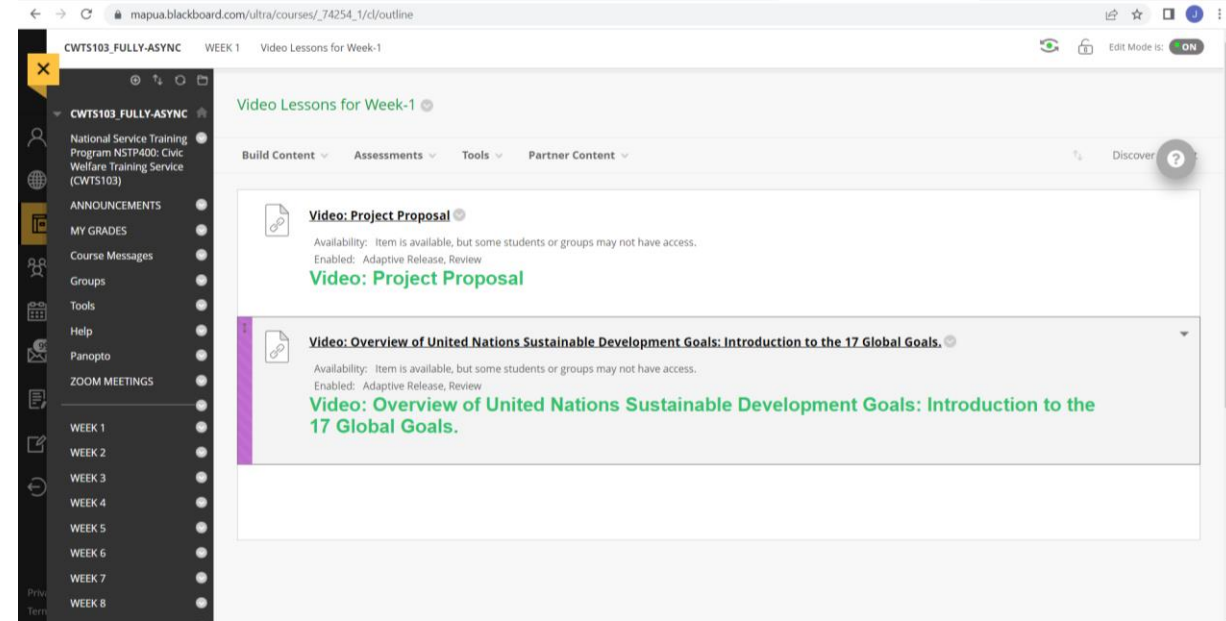


Education for SDGs: Full course on 17 SDGs covering all programs.
