Mapua holds Women in Leadership forum; highlights gender diversity as key to innovation and success in higher education

Mapua University concluded the celebration of the Women's Month with its holding of a virtual Women in Leadership Forum with the theme "Trailblazing Innovation: Empowering Women as Agents of Change" on March 28, 2025.
