Details:

The 2020 Community Conference has been a challenging activity for both the organizer and the partner communities. The said event was held in the time of the COVID-19 pandemic which poses a challenge in terms of logistics and communication. The Office for Social Orientation and Community Involvement Programs (SOCIP) together with the leaders of the partner communities managed the first virtual community conference.

The 13<sup>th</sup> Community Conference with the theme “Perfect Vision at 2020 in Attaining the UNSDGs” was held last 11 November 2020 using Zoom Meeting as its communication platform. The event was participated by 56 barangay officials from partner communities of Intramuros and Pandacan. The activity aims to present the plans and programs created through several online consultation meetings with the community representatives. The set plans were geared towards contributing to the achievement of the 17 Global Goals.

The program started with a review of the previously accomplished activities and projects. Selected Barangay Kagawads imparted stories of their experience working with the University, citing different projects done in their barangays. The testimonials focused on the capacity-building programs, technical trainings and seminar and livelihood project delivered by the



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University. They also expressed their appreciation to the University's commitment to serving and responding to community needs despite different challenges.

Then, the Director of SOCIP, Engr. Joyrence Mervin Q. Agas presented the output of the series of consultative meetings with the partner communities. The proposed projects and activities were classified according to the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs) it is contributing to. The presentation showed how the activities can be carried out in the respective barangays as well as the responsibilities of all the stakeholders.

The event highlighted the role of technology in aiding the stakeholder's initiatives for the communities given the circumstances of being physically unavailable due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and other similar occurrence. The program emphasized that changes in what people call normal can be both a challenge and opportunity to be creative and innovative in providing service to others.

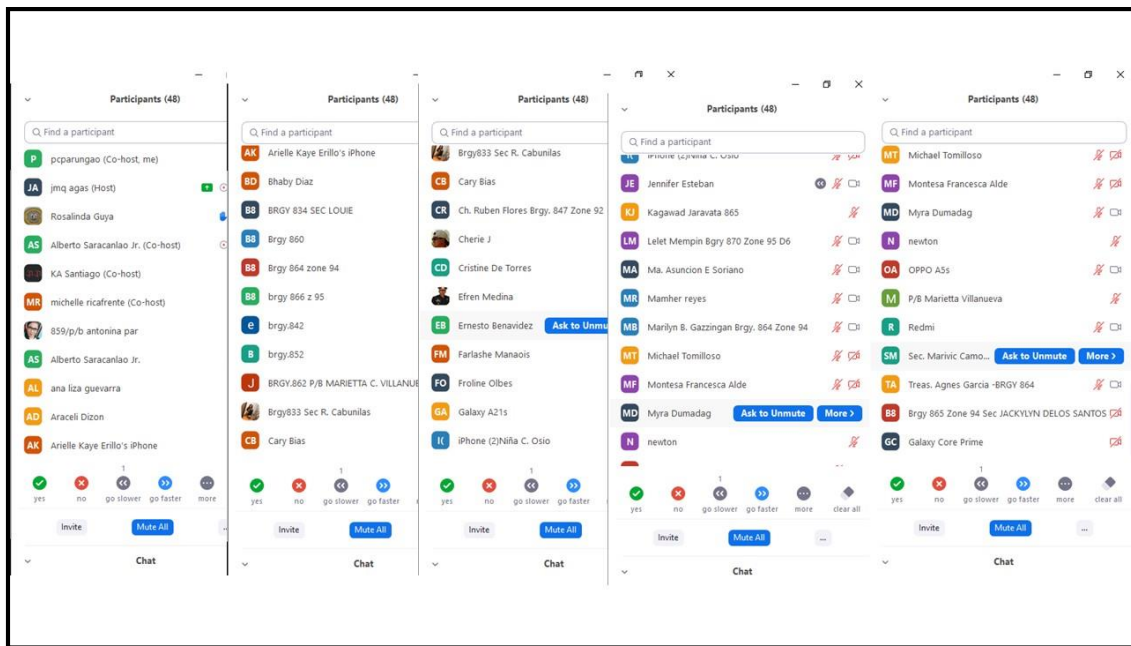

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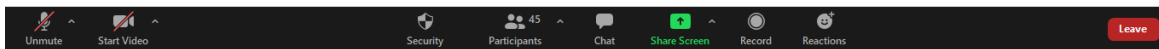

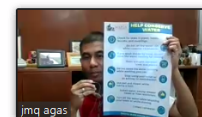

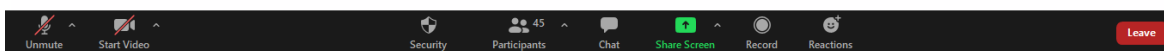
